Who is it that conquers the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

#### 5:6a–b The Answer Clarified

This is the one who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ, not with water only but with the water and the blood.

### 5:6c–8 The Testimonial Support

And the Spirit is the one that testifies, for the Spirit is the truth. There are three that testify: the Spirit and the water and the blood, and these three agree.
